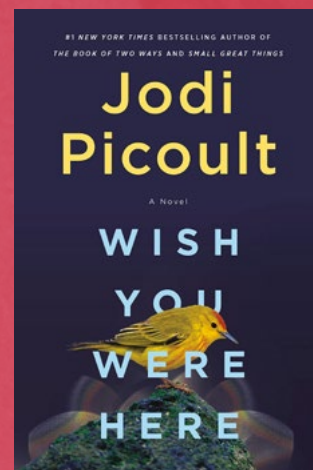
Bookworms will argue that any time of year is a good time for reading, but there's just something delightfully cozy about being cuddled up with a book while snow gently falls outside.

If you're looking for a great literary escape this winter, here are a few titles to add to your reading list.



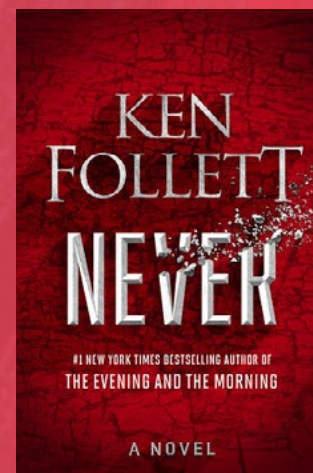
WISH YOU WERE HERE BY JODI PICOULT

Flavors From Around the Globe:

DELECTABLE RECIPES TO TRY AT HOME



If your international taste buds don't quite match your current location, try one of these simple recipes to transport yourself to your favorite foodie destination across the pond.



Herbed Goat Cheese Sandwiches

ENGLAND | Recipe courtesy of Ina Garten

Ingredients

For the spread:

- 8 ounces cream cheese, at room temperature
- 10 ½ ounces Montrachet or other mild goat cheese, at room temperature
- 1 ½ teaspoons minced garlic (2 cloves)
- ½ teaspoon minced fresh thyme leaves
- 3 tablespoons minced fresh parsley
- 5 to 6 tablespoons milk, half-and-half, or heavy cream
- ¾ teaspoon kosher salt
- ½ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

For the sandwiches:

- 2 loaves of 7-grain bread, thinly sliced
- 1 English cucumber, unpeeled

Directions

1. For the spread, place the cream cheese, goat cheese, garlic, thyme, parsley, 5 tablespoons milk, salt, and pepper in the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment. Beat on medium speed until well mixed. Add an additional tablespoon of milk if the spread is very thick.
2. To make the sandwiches, spread each slice of bread with the goat cheese spread.
3. Slice the cucumber into thin rounds and arrange on half of the bread slices.
4. Top with the remaining bread. Press slightly, trim off the crusts and cut the sandwiches into halves, thirds, or triangles. Make these sandwiches in the morning, cover with damp paper towels and plastic wrap, then refrigerate. Cut just before serving.

Aglio e Olio with Peas and Prosciutto

ITALY | Recipe courtesy of Giada De Laurentiis

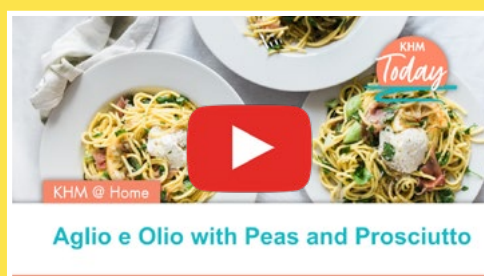
Ingredients

- Kosher salt
- ½ cup olive oil, plus more for serving, optional
- 4 ounces thinly sliced prosciutto, cut across into ¼-inch slices
- 6 cloves garlic, smashed and peeled
- 1 ½ cups frozen peas, thawed
- ¾ teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 1 pound fusilli lunghi or cavatappi pasta
- 2 cups freshly grated Parmigiano-Reggiano, plus more for serving

Directions

1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil.
2. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Add the oil and heat. Add the chopped prosciutto and cook, stirring constantly, until crispy and deep golden brown, about 4 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, remove the prosciutto to a paper towel-lined plate.
3. Reduce the heat to low. Add the garlic to the oil and cook, stirring often, until lightly golden, about 3 minutes. Add the peas, pepper flakes, and 1/8 teaspoon salt and turn off the heat.
4. Add the pasta to the boiling salted water and cook for 2 minutes less than package directions, about 9 minutes.
5. Return the skillet with the garlic oil to medium heat. Using tongs, remove the pasta from the water and add directly to the skillet with the oil. Sprinkle the bare pasta with 1 cup Parmigiano-Reggiano. Add ½ cup pasta water and toss well to coat the pasta and form a creamy sauce. Add the remaining 1 cup Parmigiano-Reggiano and up to ½ cup more pasta water to maintain a creamy sauce. Serve sprinkled with the crispy prosciutto, more Parmigiano-Reggiano, and another drizzle of olive oil, if desired.

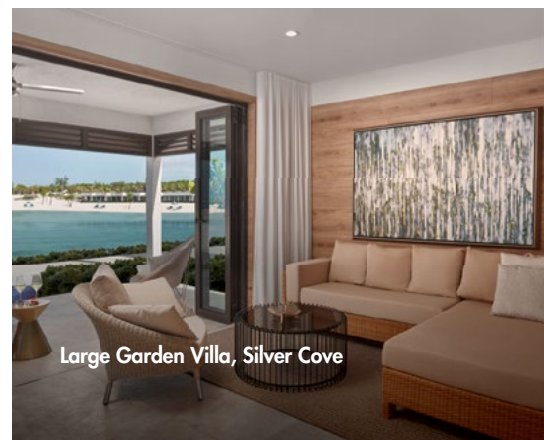

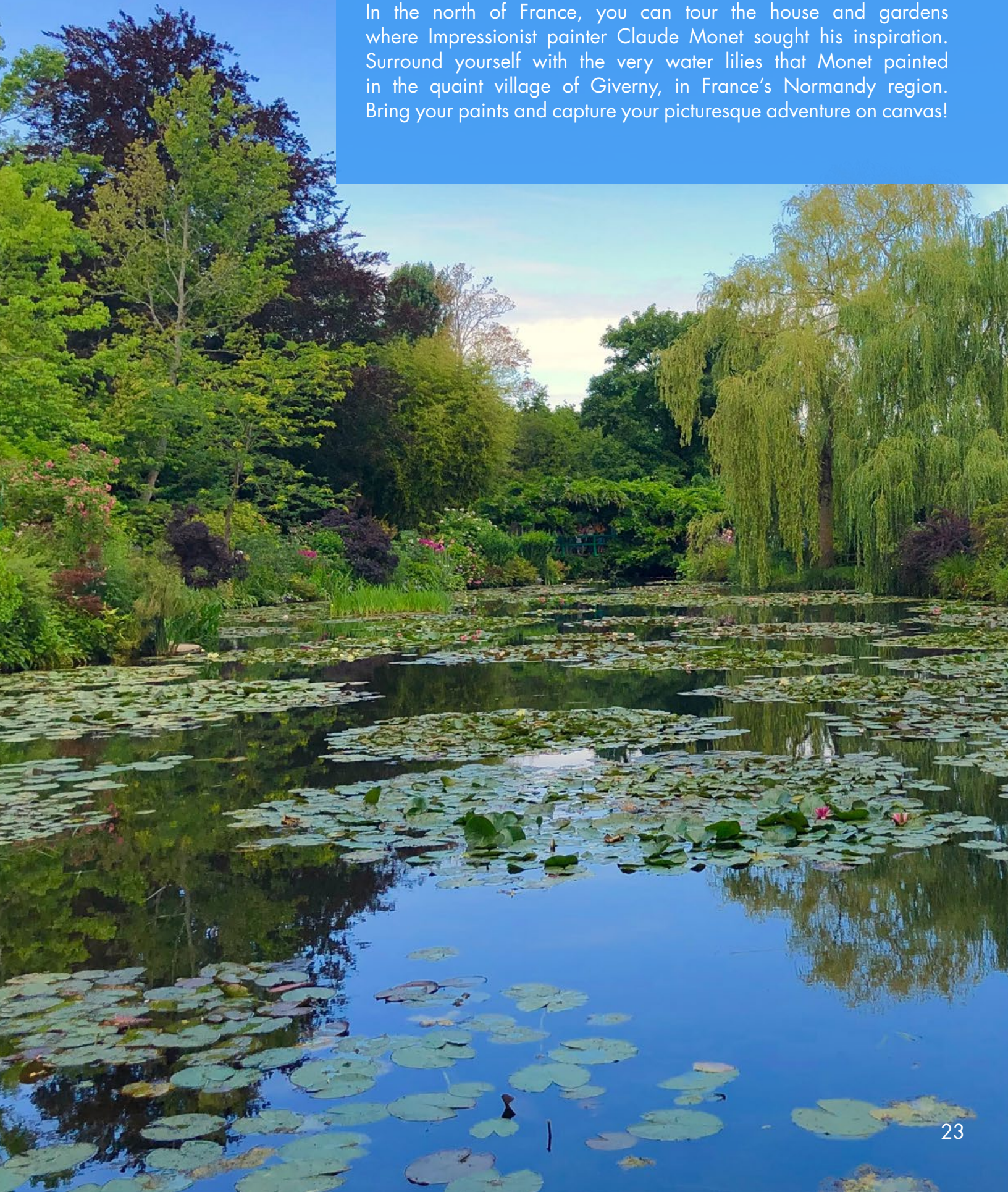
7 MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS

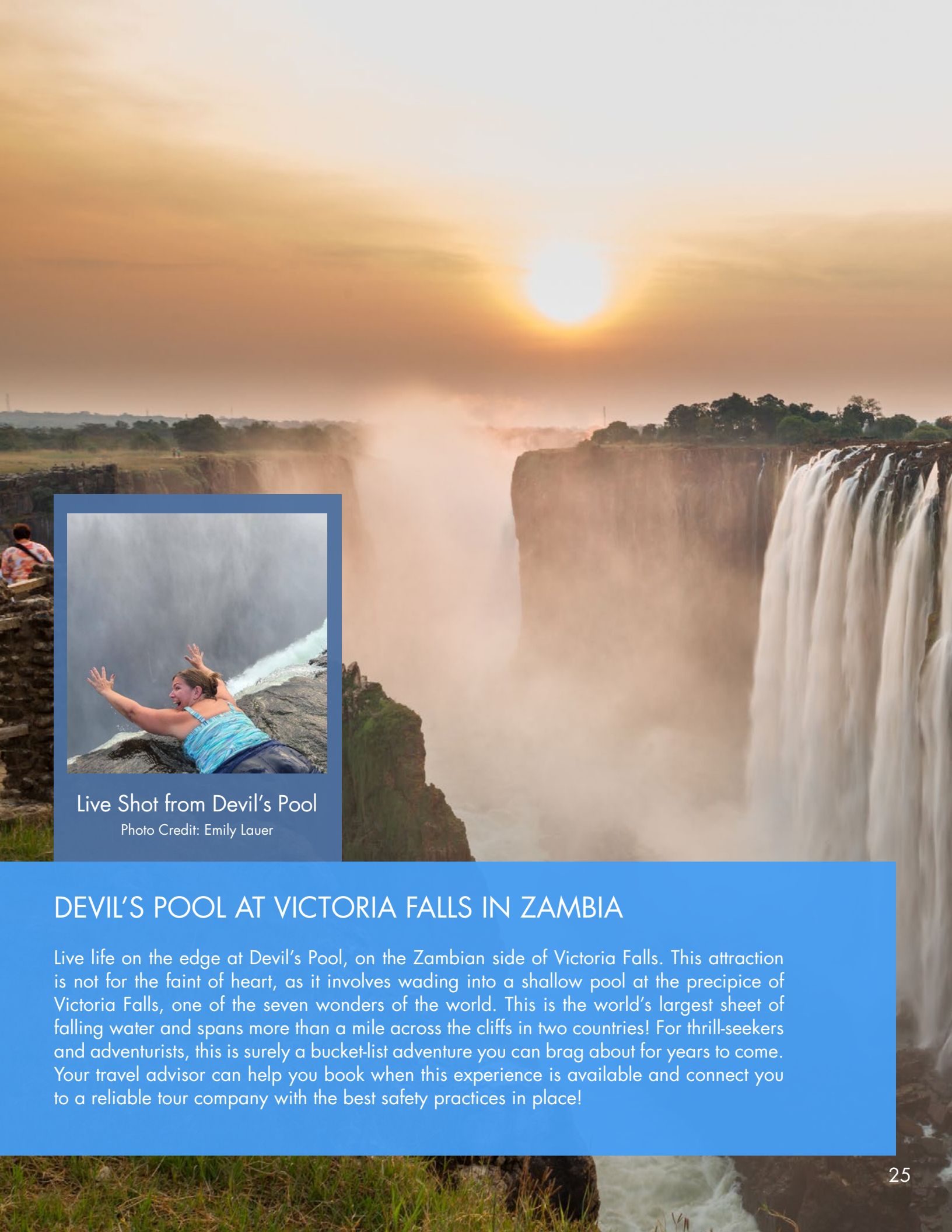

There are many cell phone camera accessories on the market that provide a fun way to capture common sites. One of the most interesting is a fish-eye lens which mimics the view of a fish underwater. Another cool prop is a glass photo ball, which flips your landscapes upside down and results in a striking photo. Packing a few camera accessories like these can help your vacation photos really stand out.

ZOOM IN TO CAPTURE DETAILS

Pair a wide-angle shot of your location with a close-up to capture details that tell a story. Everything from food, to flora, to architecture is fair game for these kinds of shots. Trying a new cuisine? Make friends with a lizard or bird along your path? See a funny sign or out of place item? These moments capture the ambiance and spirit of your destination, so snap away! Experiment with depth of field and selective focus, using your camera's portrait mode to blur the background for an artistic look. For nature photography, a zoom or macro lens is a must.

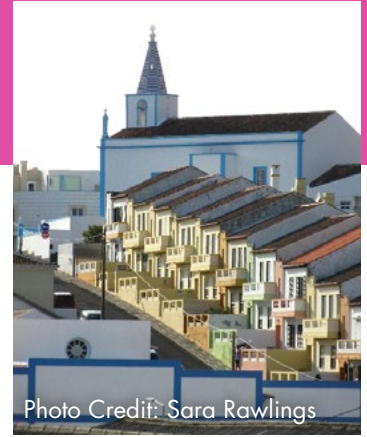

If you're hitting a beach for your next vacation, head out at sunrise or before breakfast. You'll capture photos of the pristine—and empty—paradise that awaits, before the towels are crumpled and beachgoers sprinkle the scene.

CONSIDER COMPOSITION AND COLOR

You may be familiar with the “rule of thirds,” but another way to step up your vacation photo game is to play with some of the other composition guidelines. Leading lines and repeating patterns offer unique ways to make your photos stand out in a dramatic way. Lines are everywhere from the obvious, such as the horizon line, fences, and walls, to the less obvious, like the diagonal line formed by this street in Portugal. The photographer positioned the houses in the lower right corner and used the diagonal line to draw the viewer’s eye up to the church, creating depth that captures the town’s hilly landscape perfectly.



Reflections can also make photos of buildings more interesting, along with using the colors of fall and trees to frame your photo’s main subject.



Post-trip photo editing, such as applying a black and white filter to this Colorado vacation photo, can also create a dramatic effect.

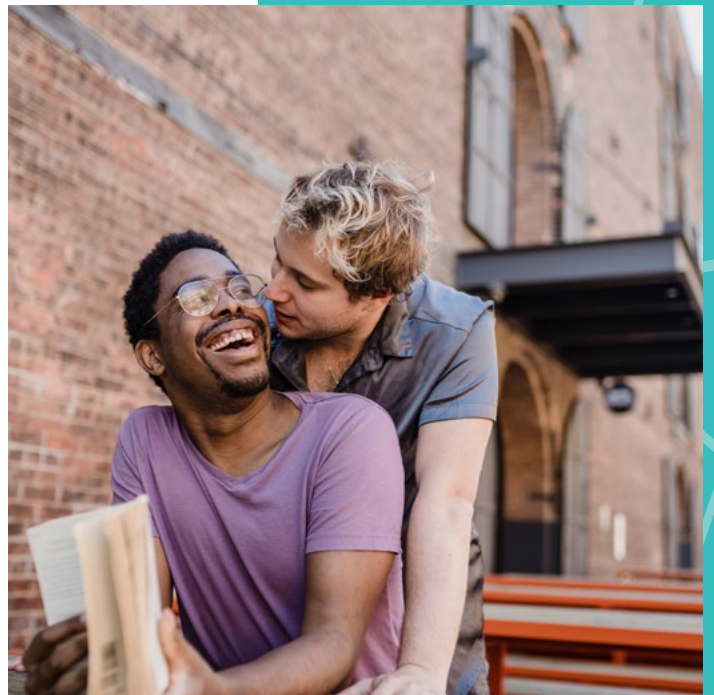

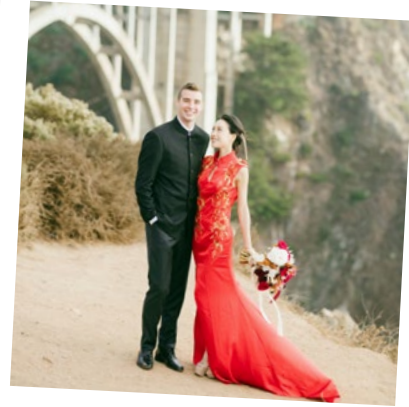
